### **ABOUT US...**

Community Living Greater Sudbury's (CLGS) mission is to foster meaningful living for all people with developmental disabilities. We are committed to the goal of assisting people who have an intellectual disability to experience their full potential. CLGS encourages people to live, work and play as valued citizens in their home and communities.

CLGS is responsible for the delivery of four programs:

**Residential Program:** We operate eight residential group homes throughout the city of Greater Sudbury where 40 people are supported.

**Day Program:** There are two drop-in centres that offer day programming for people in the community. One community-based centre serves people full-time.

**Host Family Program:** This program matches adults with a developmental disability with families who open their homes to them. Currently, there are over 50 people supported by host families throughout the city.

**Respite Service:** CLGS offers hourly and weekend respite service for host family members.

We support over 100 people and receive our funding from the Ontario government's Ministry of Children, Community and Social Services. CLGS has an operating budget of \$12 million and employs 200 people.

### **ABOUT THE BOARD...**

CLGS is a policy board with a shared view that the job of the Board is to establish the guiding principles and policies for the organization; to delegate responsibility and authority to those who are responsible for enacting these principles and policies; to monitor compliance; and to ensure that staff and Board alike are held accountable for their performance.

The Board of Directors exercises trusteeship on behalf of the organization, the corporation and the community. The Board is accountable to its funders for monies spent and to the community for services offered by the agency.

## **2019-20 DIRECTOR RECRUITMENT**

The Board is seeking applications from individuals who have experience and expertise in the following areas: legal, financial, business management, quality/performance improvement, change and system leadership.

In addition, all candidates will be required to have:

- Strong communication and critical thinking skills
- Strong consensus building skills and ability to work in a collaborative team environment
- Reside in Greater Sudbury

## **REQUIREMENTS OF DIRECTORS**

The Board will function as a results-oriented body and requires Directors to attend Board meetings including Board planning sessions and assigned committee meetings. All Directors are expected to serve on one Board Committee. A Director is generally expected to commit an average of 4-5 hours per month in preparation for and attendance at Board meetings, assigned Committee meetings and events.
